Title: Spray Painter

Scope and Purpose of the job

Responsible for preparing and painting vehicle bodies/structures to meet company standards of quality.

Main Duties

1. Complete Quality Check Form throughout paint tasks.
2. Follow Job Sheet for preparing and priming panels and repairs for paint.
3. Locate colour codes and mix up colours at priming stage, ensuring spray out cards are prepared to match panel colour. Tint colours as required.
4. Knowledge and ability to paint vehicles using Waterbourne Paint System.
5. Knowledge of proof coat, stone guard, drip check and sealing types and procedures.
6. Further knowledge of Solvent and Acrylic paint systems.
7. Operate Spray Booth and drying equipment as per Work Procedures. Maintain and service Spray Booth(s) and filters.
8. Knowledge and ability to carry out paint correction, hand polish and use polishing machine for cut & polish.
9. Wear appropriate PPE.
10. Knowledge of Jump starting modern vehicles.
11. Accurate time recording on iBodyshop.
12. Oversee and train enthusiastic Apprentices.
13. Identify, address and record safety problems within production area.

14. Adhere to the company policies, procedures and standards.
15. Maintain a clean workplace, tools and equipment.
16. Maintain equipment in a safe and serviceable condition.
17. Advise Workshop Manager of any supplements (extra damage, sublet or parts) not on Job Sheet.
